## Westover Inn

### Confirmation Agreement and Cancellation Policy

The following outlines our confirmation deposit requirements and our cancellation policy:

- 1) An initial deposit of \$50.00 per room per night is required as confirmation of the function and guest accommodation.
- 2) If cancellation is made **more than four weeks prior** to the arrival date, **all** of the deposit will be refundable.
- 3) If cancellation is made **between twenty-two and twenty-eight days prior** to the arrival date, **only** 75% of the deposit will be refundable.
- 4) If cancellation is made **between fifteen and twenty-one days prior** to the arrival date, **only** 50% of the deposit will be refundable.
- 5) The initial deposit is **non-refundable** if the reservation is cancelled between **fourteen and six days prior** to the arrival date.
- 6) The **full (RACK) room rate and 50% of the food revenue will be charged**, if the reservation is cancelled **five days or less prior** to the arrival date.
